In 1990, Devinder founded Asian Arts Inc., a company dedicated to the promotion and distribution of Indian films. By 1992, a significant transformation occurred as the company transitioned to Whitehill, marking a new chapter in its evolution.

Throughout their tenure, Devinder contributed to the growth and development of Whitehill, aligning with its vision and objectives. However, in 2009, nearing the end of the year, a pivotal decision was made to initiate production endeavors with a new partner. Regrettably, this strategic shift led to a geographical parting of ways, as the company relocated its operations to India, while Devinder chose to remain rooted in

Canada.

Beyond his professional accomplishments, Devinder cherishes his role as a husband and father. He entered into an arranged marriage and is blessed with two children, a son, and a daughter, both of whom have grown into accomplished individuals. His family has expanded to include three grandsons, two of whom excel as basketball players, while the third, Arjan Dillon, pursued higher education at NYU alongside Suhana, daughter of Bollywood superstar Shahrukh Khan.

Notable among his earlier achievements are the management of a prominent TV station and the creation of acclaimed shows such as "Screen Scene" and "Thanks for the
